

NO-SEW BLANKET SCARF



Start with a square of flannel apparel fabric at least 44 inches, be sure to wash and iron the fabric first.

Option 1

Lay out the fabric on a large flat surface, a hard floor is perfect. You'll notice that 2 sides of your fabric are already frayed. Starting at one end of the unfrayed edge and using a stick pin pull a thread from one side of the fabric all the way to the end.

Repeat this process until you have a frayed edge that you like. Move around the fabric until all sides are frayed equally.

Option 2

Lay out the fabric on a large flat surface, a hard floor is perfect.

Using a sharp scissors, cut slits across one edge of the fabric, equally spaced, about 2 inches into the fabric. Draw a horizontal line to guide your cut or use a line from the plaid to guide you.
